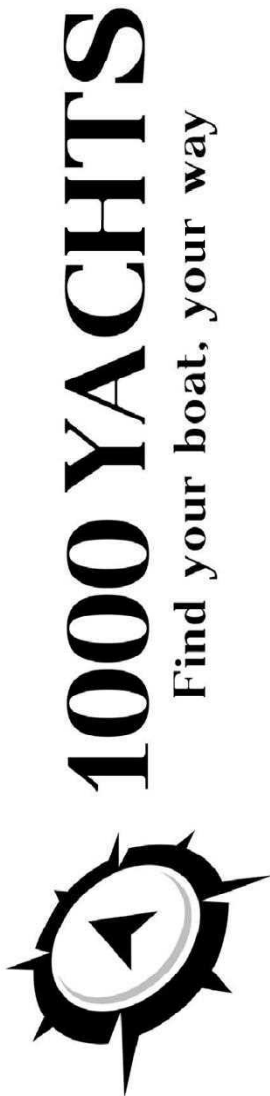
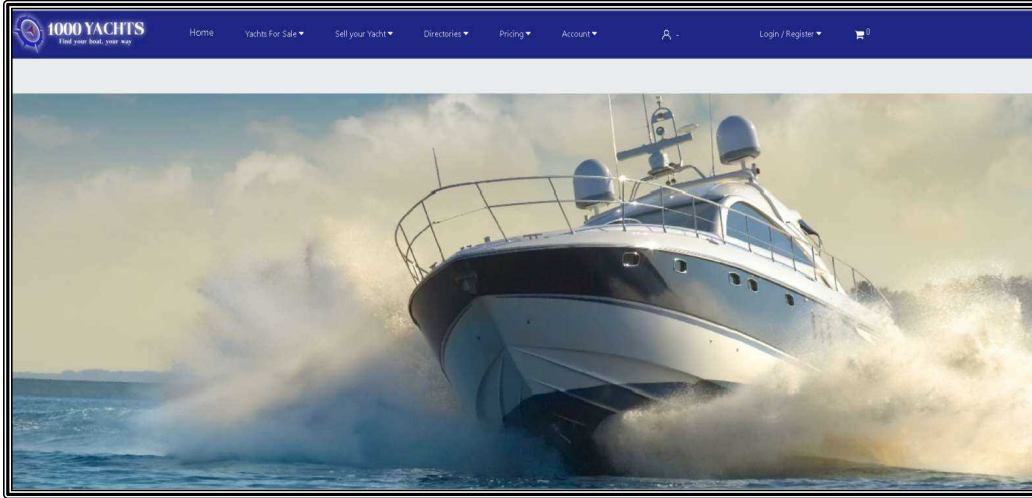
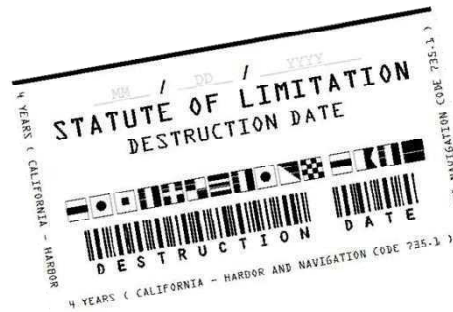

Writing a Spectacular Listing

The Listing Assistance Guide is a structured approach at acquiring complete and accurate information about a vessel. It is a step-by-step approach which provides a series of professional questions that will make anyone a seasoned boat/yacht professional. This guide allows you to simply check off basic categories, and write down various details about the vessel. This will allow you to talk with the owner, and perform a walk-through of the vessel, which will be very helpful when creating a marketing presentation and comprehensive listing.

Present the vessel in the best possible light, and focus on providing detailed information and especially data. In this way it will allow a potential buyer to decide if the vessel fits their needs and dreams. Presenting data about a vessel, in detail will allow a potential buyer to decide for themselves.

Avoid falling into the **\$1.00 pricing trap**—it may seem clever, but it actually works against you. Your listing won't appear in most buyer searches, because serious buyers set realistic **minimum and maximum price filters** to focus only on the vessels that fit their budget. Think of it this way: pricing your yacht at **\$999 million** would push it out of nearly every search. The same happens with a **\$1 listing**—you'll lose **60–70% of potential buyers** before they ever see your ad. Price strategically to attract the right audience and give your vessel the visibility it deserves.

① In order to mark the Listing as Sold, the Listing will need the Sold Price entered, which will allow the Sold status to be changed. This also frees up a Listing for another vessel.

② Boost your listing's visibility by featuring it in the **Featured Yachts** section! Not only will this give your yacht prime exposure, but as an added bonus, it will also be showcased in the **Similar Yachts** section at the bottom of comparable listings, reaching even more potential buyers.

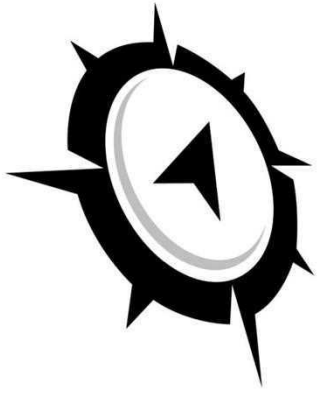
